



# Live-Fire Close Protection

This 2-day / 16-hour instructor development course is designed to teach firearms instructors how to conduct safe live-fire range training specific to dignitary / executive protection programs. There are so many unique aspects to this specialized area of firearms training that many of them are never addressed in standard firearms instructor courses. This course focuses on the use of both pistols and rifles for low profile and high risk close protection training. Even if an agency does not have a close protection program, this is great instructor development course to attend as it gives instructors a great insight on conducting dynamic "running & gunning" range drills. Prior training or experience in close protection is NOT required to attend.

*This course is approved by the NRA LE Division for 16 hours of continuing education credit.*

**NOTE:** *This course requires the use of carbines / rifles. Students don't need to be certified as a rifle instructor to attend. However, students must have successfully completed a rifle operator certification course of 16+ hours to attend this course.*

- Overview of common close protection formations
- Low profile (concealed handgun / PDW) vs. high risk (exposed rifles / carbines)
- Firearms used as impact weapons for close protection
- Range safety considerations
- Student preparation & progression of training
- 1-man, 2-man, 3-man, and 5-man protection response drills
- Use of vehicles for live-fire principal extraction drills
- Counter Assault Team / Counter Ambush Team (CAT) vehicle deployment range drills
- Disabled principal vehicle drills

- Holster and mag pouches (no concealment holsters)
- Rifle with magazines & tactical sling
- Rifle mag belt pouch
- 300 rounds of ammo for each weapon system
- A button up cove shirt or jacket

- Weather-related gear
