This hybrid 40-hour (12 hours online / 28 hours in-person) instructor certification course is designed to certify candidates as a law enforcement semi-auto rifle instructor. Upon successful completion candidates will be qualified to conduct daytime & nighttime semi-auto rifle training for recruits & sworn officers as well as conduct semi-auto rifle qualifications.

Pre-requisite: A 40-hour law enforcement pistol/handgun instructor certification from a reputable organization.

Topics Covered:

- Review of the firearms safety rules
- Review of classroom & range safety
- Rifle nomenclature, accessories, and maintenance
- Zeroing rifles
- Use of red dot sights (RDS) and variable power optics (VPO)
- Student/instructor ratios
- How to teach critical rifle skills
- Learning coaching and shooter diagnostics
- How to safely run low light drills
- How to run rifle qualifications and avoid controversy
- Teaching vs coaching
- Use of common training aids and range equipment

- Rifle magazine pouch(s) for two magazines
- Duty pistol and three magazines
- Holster & magazine pouch(s) for two magazines
- 600 rounds of rifle ammo
- 50 rounds of pistol ammo
- Eye & ear protection (clear eye pro for night shoot)
- Hat with a brim
- Hand-held flashlight
- Knee and elbow pads or shooting mat
- Black marker
- Weather-related gear
- Hydration fluids & snacks
