This 3-day / 24-hour instructor development course is designed to expand on the knowledge and skills of certified rifle/carbine instructors by introducing technical information and training methodologies for shoulder-fired select-fire weapon systems. Topics covered in the course will include an overview of various select-fire weapon systems, closed-bolt vs open-bolt operating systems, full-auto vs burst fire, policy consideration, instructor responsibilities, and training methodology.

NOTE: *Must be a certified law enforcement rifle/carbine instructor from a reputable organization to attend this course.*

- Firearms safety and instructor responsibilities
- Defining select-fire and understanding it's limitations
- Overview of common select-fire weapons
- Full-auto vs burst fire
- Closed-bolt vs open-bolt systems
- Function check for select-fire weapons
- Selector & trigger manipulation
- Operational & policy considerations
- Training methodology
