



Live-Fire CQB / Shoot House Instructor Certification Course

This 3-day / 24-hour instructor certification course is designed to teach firearms instructors how to conduct safe live-fire CQB training in a 360 degree live-fire training environment. In addition, instructors will learn how to increase the skill level and confidence of their students through proper debriefing and motivation. Live-fire training in a shoot house is the pinnacle of all firearms training...and the most challenging for firearms instructors. Not only does the instructor have to watch all things related to firearms training and safety, but also has to simultaneously evaluate and critique the application of sound CQB tactics.

This course is approved by the NRA LE Division for 24 hours of continuing education credit.

Topics Covered:

- Justifying a live-fire CQB program for patrol officers
- Shoot house construction and desired features
- Learning various CQB principles and tactics
- Safety and operational protocols
- Student preparation
- Student control techniques
- Instructor positioning
- Single room, multi-room, and full house drills
- Skill drills vs. scenario-based drills
- Conducting drills to "finality"
- Conducting low light drills
- Debriefing / facilitating student performance

Required Equipment:

- Ballistic vest or plate carrier (ballistic helmet optional)
- Pistol and three magazines
- Weapon mounted light (optional, but preferred)
- Duty belt or belt holster & mag pouches
- 400 rounds of pistol ammo (frangible ammo)
- Hand-held flashlight
- Ear protection
- Eye protection (clear eye protection for night shoot)
- Hat with a brim
- Weather-appropriate outerwear
- Hydration fluids & snacks

NOTE: Host agency CAN NOT trade out ball ammo for frangible ammo.
