This hybrid 40-hour (12 hours online / 28 hours in-person) instructor certification course is designed to certify candidates as a law enforcement shotgun instructor. The use of the shotgun for lethal, less-lethal, and specialty purposes will be covered in this course. Upon successful completion candidates will be qualified to conduct daytime & nighttime shotgun training for recruits & sworn officers as well as conduct shotgun qualifications.

Pre-requisite: A 40-hour law enforcement pistol/handgun instructor certification from a reputable organization.

- Pump action or semi-auto 12 gauge shotgun and sling (mandatory)
- Weapon mounted light recommended
- Sidesaddle on shotgun and/or belt carrier for shotgun shells
- Duty pistol and three magazines
- Duty belt with holster and ammo carriers
- 250 rounds of target loads (no smaller than 7-1/2 shot)
- 25 rounds of 00 buckshot
- 150 rounds of rifled slug
- 100 rounds of pistol ammo
- Hand held flashlight
- Eye & ear protection
- Hat with a brim
- Knee and elbow pads
- Black marker
- Weather-related gear
- Hydration fluids & snacks
