Jordan has served with the Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office (WA) since 2007 and currently serves as a patrol Sgt. During his time with his agency, Jordan has served as Rangemaster, Training Coordinator, and Lead Firearms Instructor. He has been responsible for conducting his agencies Live Fire, Force on Force, Taser and Less Lethal Instruction. In addition, Jordan has extensive experience as a marine patrol officer/trainer and Search and Rescue Incident Commander.



Over the several years Jordan has taken his agency's firearms training from static stand and shoot training to enhanced live-fire tactics with movement, communication, moving targets, and higher accountability. Jordan started his agencies Active Shooter Response program as well as live-fire vehicular assault and CQB programs.

Jordan holds instructor certificates from the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission in Advanced Handgun, Patrol Rifle and Shotgun as well as Instructor certificates for Active Shooter Response, Taser, Less Lethal and Chemical Munitions, Low Light, Live-Fire Shoot House, and Scenario Based Training. Jordan has conducted and extensive trained in live-fire, active shooter, and force-on-force training courses and holds several armorers certificates for patrol duty weapons. He is also an active member with the Washington State Law Enforcement Firearms Instructor Association (WSLEFIA), ILEETA, and NRA. Jordan is also a staff instructor with the National Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors Association (NLEFIA).

Jordan has chaired his agency's use of force review committee and was the lead author in his agency's updated use of force policy and was responsible for training his agency on updated use of force protocols. He is a graduate of the Force Science Institute and is a member on the Lower Columbia Regional SWAT Team where he serves as lead firearms instructor and chemical/impact munitions instructor. Jordan has a passion for firearms training both at the instructor level and as a student by attending as much outside instruction as possible from some of the industry's leading instructors.
